Bridle Numbers

All horses competing in the World Cup Class have been allocated a bridle number. Bridle numbers MUST be displayed on both sides of either the bridle or saddle cloth when competing or under saddle, and on either the bridle or headstall at any time they are outside of their stables. It is the responsibility of the rider to provide their own bridle numbers and holders to display the allocated number.

FEI – health monitoring

It is an FEI requirement that you have taken your horses temperature 3 days prior to your arrival at the event and logged in the FEI HorseApp. Ensure you have completed your horse's Self-Certification Form.

Arrivals

World Cup horses must be present on the grounds* by **midday Friday 23rd June**, and will be checked in by FEI Steward and Member of the OC.

Arrival inspections will take place at **8.00am Saturday 24th June**. The vet and steward will come to your stable. Please have your horse's passport, thermometer, a handler and horse ready.

Trot up will take place at **9.30am Saturday 24th June** at the QSEC Stable Complex. Please be on time and ready with bridle numbers and passport. Stallions first please and then in bridle number order where possible.

- ◆ No nominations will be accepted after closing date
- ◆ Number of Starts: Maximum of two starts per horse/day . Per rider in a class – No rider will be permitted more than three (3) entries in a class.
- ◆ **Equestrian Australia Waivers** must be signed for your entry to be accepted – form on Equipe
- ◆ **Horse Health Declarations** must be supplied on arrival or emailed prior to competition – form on Equipe. Prize money will be withheld if form not supplied.
- ◆ Juniors **cannot** compete in Young Rider on the same horse.
- ◆ **PRESENTATION** Riders must present at presentation mounted (stallions may be substituted for presentation) or prizemoney is forfeited.
- ◆ **Draws** will be posted on EQUIPE and the events will run to draw order
- ◆ Wait lists will be created for classes if over-subscribed, and competitors will be notified of acceptance once nominations are finalised.
- ◆ Entries will only be accepted once your payment has been processed

Tour rules

- ◆ Ruby Tour: Horses 40pts and under **or** 8yo and under
- ◆ Emerald Tour: Horses 20pts and under **or** 6yo and under
- ◆ Amateur, Young Rider & Junior Tours: Per EA rules
- ◆ Childrens' Tour: Rider aged 14 years and under as at 17th June 2023
- ◆ Horse/rider combination **must compete** in two of three rounds for ruby, emerald & junior tours or one of two rounds for all other tours to be eligible for final.
- ◆ Tour Final draws will be seeded per leaderboard for each tour
- ◆ For restricted classes, points or age will be determined as of Saturday 17th June 2023
- ◆ A horse may only compete in **ONE** Tour Final
- ◆ **QOTT Bonus Eligibility:** Off-The-Track Horse is a Thoroughbred or Standardbred that has been, or is eligible to be, registered for thoroughbred racing or harness racing in Australia.

- ◆ **TSHA Classes Eligibility:** Horses must obtain a TSHA competition license to enter these classes. License is available on Global Entries Online (Manage Horses). Only horses with Thoroughbred Stud Book registration will be accepted. No part bred Thoroughbreds. For full details including how to obtain a license, visit: www.thoroughbredsporthorse.com.au
- ◆ **Greg Grand Up & Coming Series Rules**
 - Horses must be EA Life Registered - owner ridden or leased
 - Horses must be in their first or second year of EA Full Life Horse Registration (based on calendar year): i.e., 2022 or 2023.
 - Horses must have 16 points and under to be eligible to compete.
- ◆ **First Aid Levy** \$10 per rider / day
- ◆ **Ground Fee** \$10 per horse / show
- ◆ **Admin/Scoring Fee** \$10 per horse / show
- ◆ **Changes:** Each change to nominations after the close of entries will attract a \$5 administration fee. Any changes must be made by 4.00pm the day prior to class. Changes must be made at office.

Conditions of Entry

- ◆ **Refunds:** Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$25 administration fee, please contact the OC as refunds are not done automatically. After entries have closed, a 50% refund will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate. Once the event has commenced there will be no refunds given. Riders may be required to present horse registration/performance cards upon request of the committee. All registrations/memberships will be checked by Equestrian Queensland.
- ◆ **Unofficial Classes** (under 105cm) are open to Equestrian Australia members and current financial members of Queensland Showjumping Club.
- ◆ **DISCLAIMER** – statement of liability – neither the organising committee of The Queensland Showjumping Club, QSEC or Equestrian Queensland accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectator or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- ◆ Damage to any third party by anyone at the competition will be the responsibility to the adult involved or the parents/guardians of those who cause the damage.
- ◆ **HELMETS** – Australian helmet standards will apply – ALL helmets must be tagged.
- ◆ **DRESS** – all riders to be dressed in accordance with FEI requirements and those attired incorrectly will not be permitted to start.
- ◆ **HORSE BOOTS**—For any class or section of a class with an age requirement or limitation, the YH Boot Rule will apply
- ◆ **SWABBING** – the organising committee reserves the right to swab horses. Random swabbing of horses may be conducted in any official class. Horses chosen for swabbing must proceed directly to the swabbing area immediately after presentation.
- ◆ **BEHAVIOUR** – all competitors must obey Equestrian Australia rules and competition etiquette. Those who fail to do so risk elimination from the competition.
