

Festival of Showjumping 2022

Conditions Of Entry

- All nominations via Equipe : Open at 8:00pm on Monday 23rd May.
- Nominations close: 8:00pm Monday 13th June
- NO nominations will be accepted after closing date. NO nominations will be taken during the event.
- Number of Starts: ONE start per horse/day over all arenas Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
TWO starts/rounds per horse is permitted on Thursday only.
- Wait lists will be created for classes if needed and competitors will be notified of acceptance once nominations are finalised.
- Entries will only be accepted once your payment has been processed.
- [Equestrian Australia Waivers](#) must be signed for your entry to be accepted – Form on Equipe
- [Horse Health Declarations](#) must be supplied on arrival – Form on Equipe. Prize money will be held if form not supplied.
- The organising committee reserves the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend the program or any of the conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit.
- This event is run under Equestrian Australia rules.
- Draws will be posted on EQUIPE and the events will run to draw order.
- Scratching's after close of entries, will receive a refund of your entry fees less administration fee of \$5 and only if accompanied by a vet or doctor's certificate. Refunds will be processed after the event.
- Changes to nominations after the close of entries will be subject to a \$5 administration fee.
- First aid will be in attendance.
- Official Classes are open to Equestrian Australia members only. Proof of membership must be provided. All riders and owners must be financial members of EQ to compete in official classes and all horses competing in official classes must hold current EA registration and performance cards. Riders may be required to present horse registration/performance cards upon request of the committee. All registrations/memberships will be check by Equestrian Queensland.
- Unofficial Classes (under 105cm) are open to Equestrian Australia members and current financial members of Queensland Showjump Club.
- **DISCLAIMER** – statement of liability – neither the organising committee of The Queensland Showjump Club, QSEC or Equestrian Queensland accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectator or any other persons or property whatsoever.

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- Damage to any third party by anyone at the competition will be the responsibility to the adult involved or the parents/guardians of those who cause the damage
- **HELMETS** – Australian helmet standards will apply – ALL helmets must be tagged.
- **DRESS** – all riders to be dressed in accordance with FEI requirements and those attired incorrectly will not be permitted to start.
- **SWABBING** – the organising committee reserves the right to swab horses. Random swabbing of horses may be conducted in any official class. Horses chosen for swabbing must proceed directly to the swabbing area immediately after presentation.
- **BEHAVIOUR** – all competitors must obey Equestrian Australia rules and competition etiquette. Those who fail to do so risk elimination from the competition.
- A horse can only compete in **ONE** championship class.
- Horse may **not** compete in both World Cup and Mini Prix
- Juniors **cannot** compete in Young Rider on the same horse.
- Juniors **cannot** compete in 1.10 & 1.20 Junior classes on the same horse.
- The age of the horse and the points they have will remain as from the START of the show.
- **PRESENTATION** Riders must present at presentation mounted (stallions may be substituted for presentation) or prizemoney is forfeited.
- It is expected that all riders and their staff have read and accepted these conditions of entry and the rules & regulations of QSEC.
